A big seven-piece outfit, the group boasted a saxophonist, keyboardist, drummer, rhythm and bass guitar plus two lead singers, Noel Ashton and female vocalist Natalie Jenkin-Smith, who brought us classics from Madonna, Tiffany, Toni Basil, Kim Wilde and Katrina and the Waves. One ovation wasn't enough and the band returned no fewer than three times allowing us to enjoy afresh classics from The Human League, ABC and Wham! It was like the intervening 30 years had just melted away.
